Our Programs

Teen Success Inc. is now Shine Together Inc.

Harmony At Home partners with Shine Together Inc. to break cycles of poverty for multiple generations through the power of education. Navigating barriers as a young mom while remaining engaged in academics can feel impossible with limited support. Shine Together provides a springboard for young mothers to be successful by helping them finish high school and pursue post-secondary education. Through weekly support groups and individual coaching, it empowers members to reach their full potential by developing concrete goals and plans for a bright future. The mission of Shine Together Inc. is to transform the lives of young mothers and their children by helping them become educated, self-sufficient, and valued members of society.

Our program doubled in size this year allowing us to serve 61 young families across Monterey County. Program participants received ongoing individual and peer support in education navigation, early childhood development, financial well-being, and health and wellness. Program services slowly shifted from virtual to in-person adhering to health and safety protocols. This shift proved the power of connection as numerous young moms expressed gratitude for the opportunity to connect with other moms in the community. All program participants continued to receive essential resources for their child's development including diapers, wipes, clothing, and emergency financial assistance.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- 17 new members were enrolled this year.
- 15 members completed High School and one graduated from College

Children 1st

Co-parenting Education Program for Divorcing and Separating Families

The most difficult part of the divorce process, for most children, is the prolonged and unresolved conflict that arises out of the parent’s reaction to the pain of divorce/separation or to each other’s behavior. Children 1st addresses these issues. Parents learn how to acknowledge their own part of the problem in order to reduce the level of conflict in the co-parenting relationship and the effects it has on their children.

We are excited to announce we were awarded a Heal Together Grant through the Hospice Giving Foundation, to expand our services that help build strong family relationships. With this grant, we are able to expand Children 1st throughout Monterey County to families who are managing the difficult and painful transition of family separation and/or divorce.

One of the main reasons children are being referred to our counseling programs is due to trauma related to parental separation. We are partnering up with local schools to help facilitate our co-parenting education classes at no charge to the families.

Our goal is to remove all barriers for families to attend the Children 1st classes. We do this by offering the program at local schools and providing dinner, snacks, and child care so that parents can focus on the content covered in the curriculum without worry. Upon completion of the program parents and children are awarded a certificate of completion. We are very excited to expand our program and bring this service to the schools and the community throughout Monterey County.

This program is offered individually, in person, or virtually. To date, we have hosted 8 group classes at Greenfield High, paired up King City High School and Portola Butler High School, and Cesar Chavez Elementary School to facilitate group sessions. We offer scholarships to self-referred clients, thanks to the Heal Together Grant.

HIGHLIGHTS:

Parents who have graduated from our program are invited to attend and participate in our ongoing support groups.

We facilitate groups for mothers and fathers where we cover different themes, hold space for parents to share their experiences, or find commonalities with other adults who may be going through similar cases.

Many of the families we have worked with feel empowered, the children openly share their experiences and parents have found a safe space in our groups for graduates.

Bullying Prevention

Harmony At Home (HAH) has provided bullying prevention support to the County of Monterey for a decade through the Olweus Bullying Prevention Program (OBPP) and with Student-Led Assemblies (SLA). During the 2021-2022 school year HAH supported 14 schools.

During the past decade of implementing bullying prevention, HAH has identified ways to better support our students, parents, and teachers. Based on the data that we have compiled over the past year, it is clear that our community will benefit from a more comprehensive approach to addressing the social and emotional needs of our children and youth. We will now be offering, not only Harmony At Home's Bullying Prevention Program, which is a combination of bullying prevention support and support with the student-led assembly, but also mental health support, psycho-education, and educational resources for school staff.

With Harmony At Home's Bullying Prevention Program, students are supported in the implementation of a Student-Led Assembly at their school site. After the SLA is delivered, students will continue to receive support from a HAH Bullying Prevention Coach. Our bullying prevention team will continue to support parents with parent workshops in English and in Spanish on various issues in regards to bullying and will provide staff support throughout the school year with training and staff refreshers in bullying prevention.

Looking into the future

- For the 2022-2023 school year HAH is in contract with 48 schools throughout Monterey County, supporting our community with bullying prevention.
- HAH will be supporting schools with Bullying Prevention in the following districts: Salinas City Elementary School District, Alisal Union School District, King City School District, the Aromas San Juan School District, Santa Rita School District, Soledad School District, San Ardo School District, San Antonio School District and Salinas Union High School District.
- HAH will be expanding the bullying prevention team by hiring 11 Bullying Prevention Coaches.

About Miguel

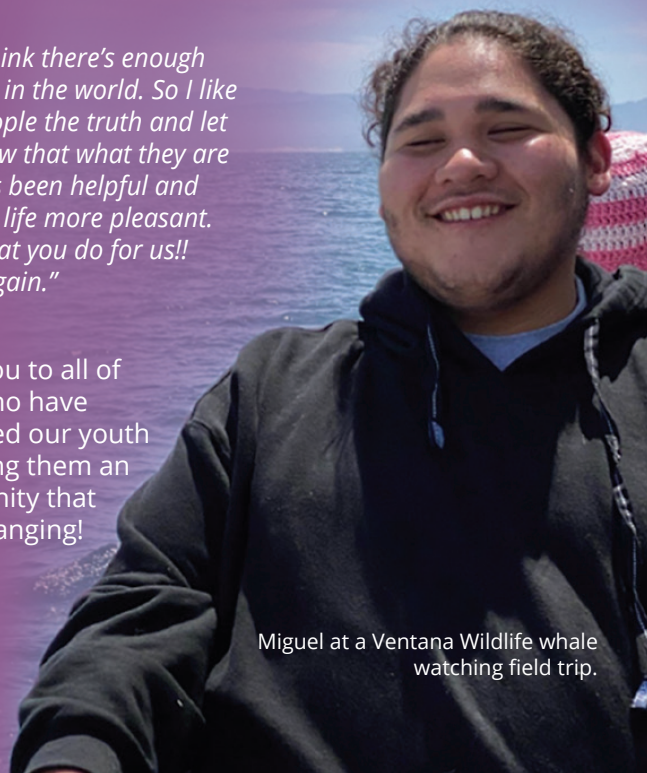

Teen Programs

This past school year one of our Seasoned Licensed Therapists, Gail B, provided 36 youth ranging from freshman to seniors from Monterey County Office of Education (MCOE) alternative education program with mental health support. We are proud to report that 3 graduated High School, which is quite an accomplishment considering most of the students that come to us are often behind in credits and in some cases a few years worth. This Alternative Education program that we provide support to will have all grade levels in a classroom, and not all of these students will meet the requirements for graduation. Many of them have been excessively truant, in Juvenile Hall and/or a Youth Center. The real success story is that they are actually attending school. Due to excessive truancy and other challenges, our students often "age out" of high school without a high school diploma and they will continue their studies post high school and achieve their educational success through an Adult Education program.

This upcoming school year we will be continuing to grow our relationship with Monterey County Office of Education's Alt. Ed. program and we are excited to announce that we will also be partnering with Rancho Cielo to provide the school community with a full time Mental Health Professional. We will continue serving youth who have experienced a multitude of trauma-related experiences, helping them to process their trauma. The focus of the trauma-informed treatment is to help the youth process their trauma, work through it with compassionate support and ultimately envision the possibilities and opportunities that they can experience in their lives and to recognize the importance of the choices they make today.

Unfortunately, Covid 19 disrupted our Teen Enrichment Summer Camp programs and we are just now regrouping and getting back on track. This year we will be working on our Youth Mentoring Programs that will help set up the Summer Camps for 2023.

Harmony At Home has been supporting youth in breaking cycles of violence and abuse since the start. We have clients who went through our programs as teens and are now in their 20's and early 30's. The young adults who report back to us on how they are doing all say that if it wasn't for Harmony At Home they very likely would not be functioning or even alive.

Sticks & Stones®

Our Sticks & Stones® school-based counseling program targets children and youth who have experienced trauma which is negatively impacting their overall functioning. The program uses evidence-based cognitive behavioral strategies to best address the trauma they may be holding, which if not addressed, can not only negatively impact learning opportunities, but also social and emotional functioning.

For the 2nd year in a row, we have continued to experience a significant increase in the needs for our services. We experienced a shortage in staffing but were still able to serve hundreds of students. Returning from the pandemic, this year was the 1st full year back in person at the school sites. We witnessed the effects of how being deprived from social interaction has impacted students and it has allowed us to identify changes in recommendation trends which led us to create our Comprehensive Social-Emotional Support (SES) package for the upcoming year. This package was presented to all of our partners and it was well received. Our new Comprehensive SES package will allow Harmony At Home to have a greater presence at most school sites, have deeper collaborations and serve more students, staff and parents.

We are excited to bring our school-based counseling programs, Bullying Prevention and Children 1st to most school sites.

Their love story is one, fairytales are written about. They dated for six years and got married in 2013. They have three beautiful daughters: Trinity (11), Bianca (7), and Tatiyana (15 months).

Jose is on the Board of Directors for Harmony At Home. He joined two years ago. "The value of improving people's home lives, that of teens, families, kids, and improving interpersonal relationships, makes me excited," said Jose. "Harmony At Home's programs bring the vision to scale."

Their professional success is due to their hard work. Jose graduated from San Jose State University in Recreation and Leisure Studies and Brenda from Chapman University in Organizational Leadership.

As Salinas' Community Safety Administrator for the past nine years, Jose has brought professionalism, engagement, and awareness to the business and non-profit community. He also volunteers for the Juvenile Justice Commission and Cal Violence Prevention Network. Jose leads the Community Alliance for Safety and Peace.

As a board member Jose is a volunteer, a donor, and an advocate who helps to find resources to fulfill HAH's mission.

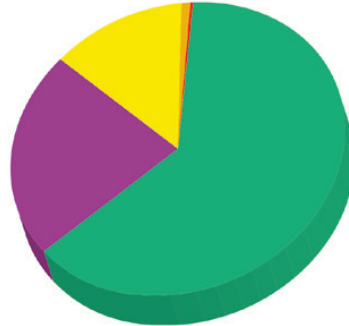

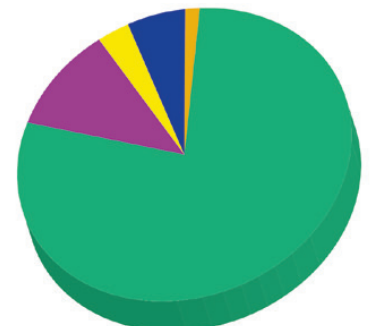

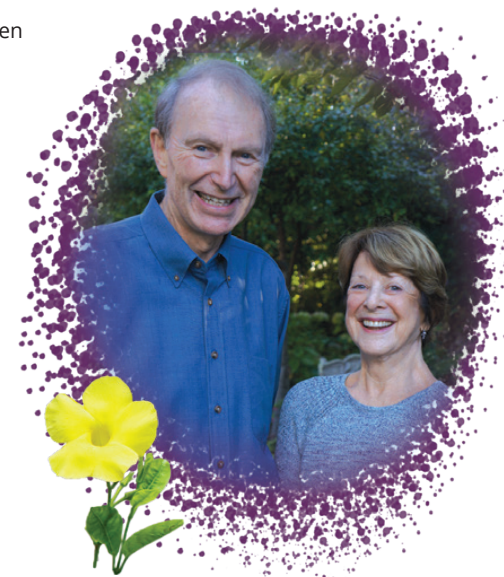
